

Supplier Code of Conduct

Fabrinet expects its employees and its suppliers to conduct themselves in accordance with Fabrinet's Code of Conduct, which seeks to deter wrongdoing and to promote:

- 1. Honest and ethical conduct, including the ethical handling of actual or apparent conflicts of interest between personal and professional relationships;
- 2. Full, fair, accurate, timely and understandable disclosure in reports and documents that the Company files with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC"), and in other public communications by the Company;
- 3. Compliance with all applicable governmental laws, rules and regulations;
- 4. Prompt internal reporting to an appropriate person or persons identified in the Code, of any and all violations of the Code; and
- 5. Accountability for adherence to the Code.

In addition to our Code of Conduct, we expect our suppliers to operate in accordance with the principles of the Responsible Business Alliance ("RBA"), formerly the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC), Code of Conduct. The RBA Code of Conduct is a set of standards on social, environmental and ethical issues in the electronics industry supply chain, including responsible operations and management in labor, health & safety, environmental and ethics. As part of our commitment to corporate social responsibility, and to respecting human rights in our operations and global supply chain, Fabrinet has adopted the RBA policy for conflict minerals and its reporting format. Because of this, we expect our suppliers to do so too, and to have policies and due diligence measures in place that will enable us to be reasonably sure that components and materials supplied to us are conflict-minerals free, so we in turn can assure our customers of that too.
